Music

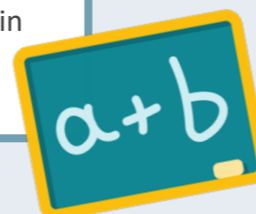
- Vocal work learning melodies and lyrics and working on performance skills

How parents can support learning at home:

- Plant some seeds and watch them grow in different conditions
- Share some seaside books together
- Practise telling the time and drawing clocks
- Measure and weigh items at home in centimetres (cm)
- Start writing a diary, a few sentences each day and see how your writing changes over time
- Enjoy a walk by the river spotting plants, birds and animals
- Read some religious stories together and talk about them
- Talk to grandparents about holidays in the past.
- Write a short story in “Word” then change the colour and font (ICT)
