## How parents can support learning at home:

- Read a range of Shakespeare's stories (adapted from his plays for children – see Orchard Books)
- Go on a nature walk, look at various flowers and try to design your own classification key
- Investigate how simple electrical items work, e.g. a torch
- Practise working out time durations of films, trips, meal preparations etc.
- Listen to "Wow in the World" podcasts
- Create a powerpoint presentation that incorporates music and images
- Visit a place of worship – e.g. a mosque, church or synagogue
- Encourage girls to help in the shopping, preparation and cooking of meals.
